NEW OFFICIAL TENNESSEE SPECIALTY LICENSE PLATE

LET NO FALLEN OFFICER BE FORGOTTEN!



The State of Tennessee approved a new, official 'Specialty License Plate for all Tennessee registered vehicles. This official vehicle license plate is available to ALL Tennesseans.

We are currently taking reservations for the "Honoring The Fallen" license plates. The TN fee is \$35. The \$35 is the normal TN Specialty Plate fee. Act NOW and you can choose your plate number between 1 - 1,000. (Sorry, until issuance, no letters, or numbers over 1000).

** Plate Design is not final and may be adjusted to comply with Tennessee's guidelines ** Checks can be made out to: Middle & East TN COPS

If we are unable to reach our goal of 1,000 reservations, you will be refunded the \$35 reservation fee To personalize a plate with a number over 1,000 or with letters, you need to secure a random plate number first. Once the initial plates are finalized and sent to your county office, you'll be able to apply for a personalized plate.
